General guidelines:

It is forbidden to own chametz on Pessach (Passover). This prohibition starts in the middle of the morning before Pessach (the exact hour varies from place to place).

Chametz products that we don't want to dispose of may be sold to a non Jew before Pessach, and purchased back after Pessach.

The chametz which is sold should not be left open in places that are in active use, but rather be put away in a designated place which is clearly marked.

The bill of sale appoints and empowers the Rav to be an agent to sell the chametz to a non Jew.

After Pessach, the Rav purchases the chametz back, and it is then permissible to use.

The bill of sale must be signed and forwarded to the Rav by Sunday (March 28 2010) at 8:00 P.M. (Israel time).
